SWAKOPMUND

Swakopmund is a coastal city in Namibia, west of the capital, Windhoek. Its sandy beaches face the Atlantic Ocean. Established by German colonists in 1892, the city's colonial landmarks include the Swakopmund Lighthouse and the Mole, an old sea wall. Next to the lighthouse, the Swakopmund Museum documents Namibian history.

DAY 7: JUNE 2ND

SWAKOPMUND-WALVIS BAY

In the morning we will Boat Cruise: boat cruise is done in the Harbour and offers you an experience to enjoy marine life of the Atlantic Ocean and explore Namibia coastline wildlife. Boat cruise is 3 hours long but offers the best of what the Atlantic can offers. Breakfast and a short transfer to Walvis bay for our boat cruise and afternoon discover what others talk about, this hidden place called Sandwich Harbour. The place of myth and historical value to Namibia and a must seen place in Namibia. Back in the afternoon to our shore and time to relax.
